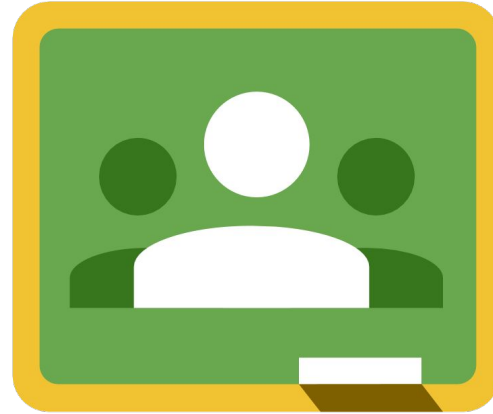

Think of Google Classroom as your child's digital link to learning.

Teachers use Google Classroom to share assignments, homework, newsletters, and much more with students!

Google Classroom is a protected learning space for teachers and students. Parents cannot be invited to the classroom but can receive optional email summaries.



What is Google Classroom?

Your child was provided with a secure login and password that is unique to them.

Check with his/her teacher to obtain this private information OR ask them to add you as a parent via email!

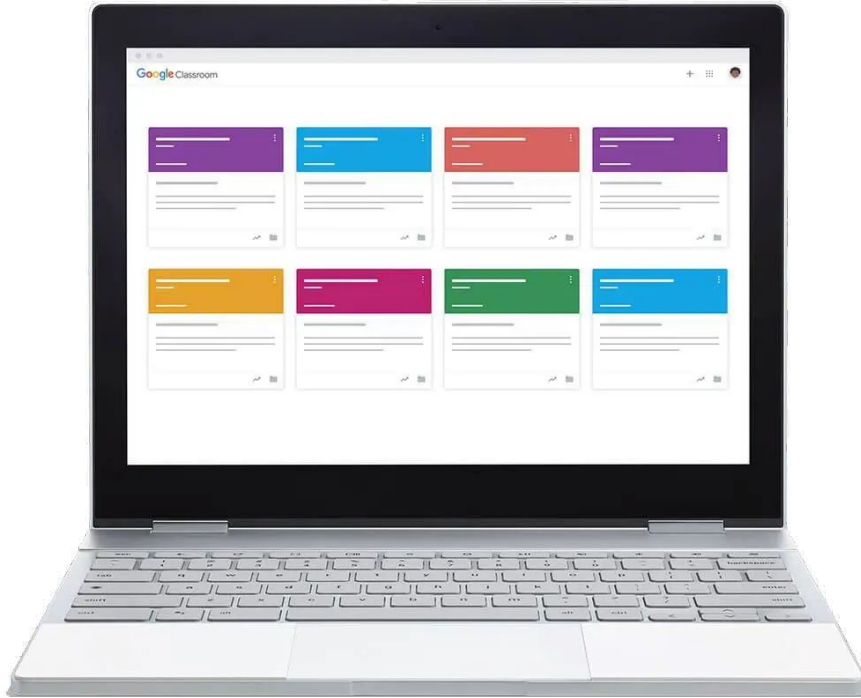

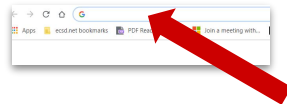

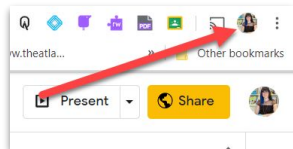

1 Open the Google Chrome browser 

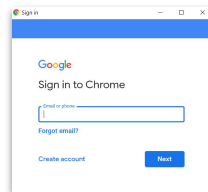
2 Type www.google.com into your web address bar.



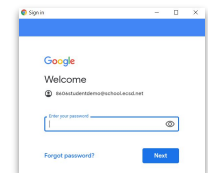
3 Click on SIGN IN in the upper right hand corner of the browser window. If you are logged in as a parent then add a person.



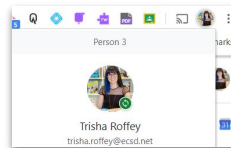
4 Type in your child's Google Email address & click "next." You use the credentials provided by the school below

Replace the X's with the students 7 digit ID number

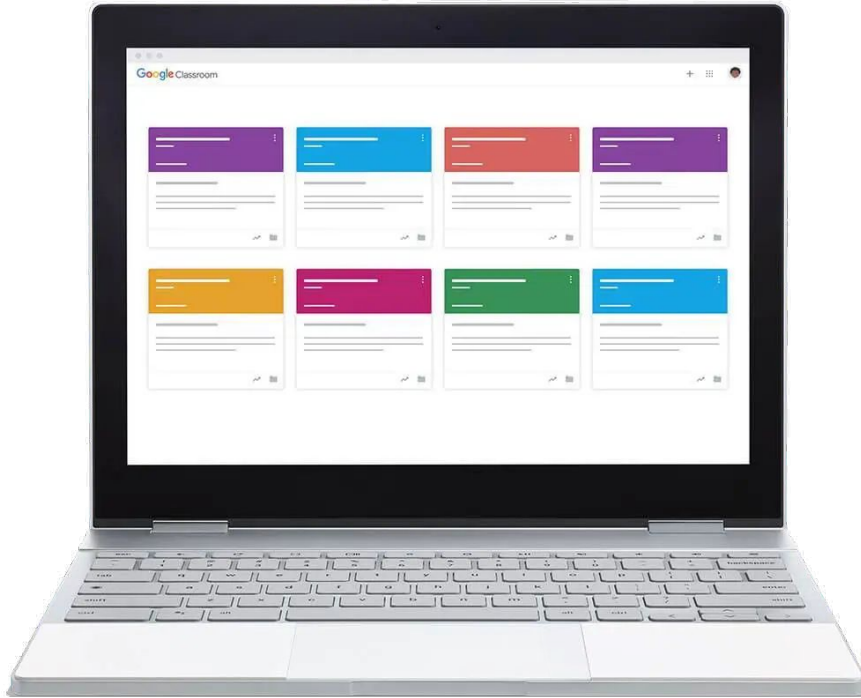


5 Type in the student PASSWORD & click "next." The password is unique to each child.



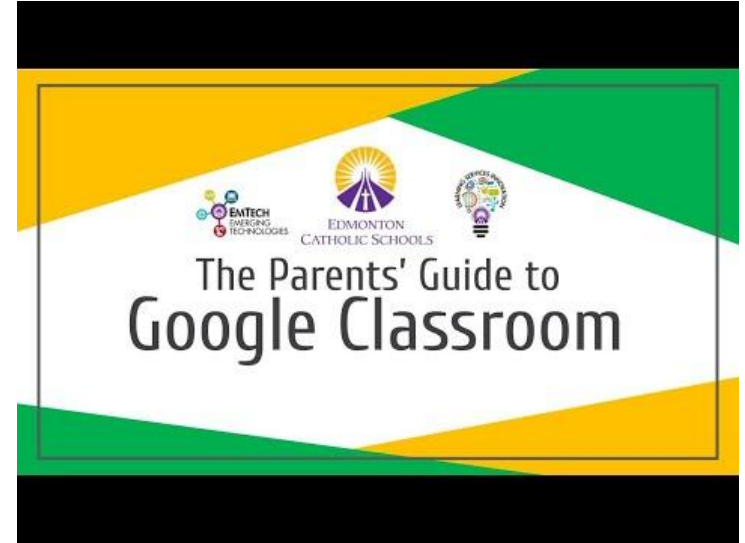
6 Now you will see that the student is signed in to their Google Apps for Education account!





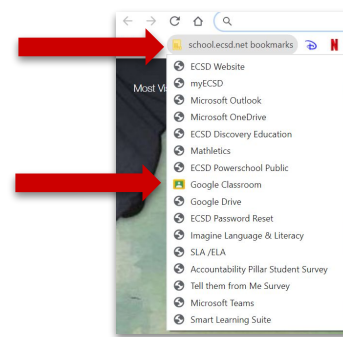

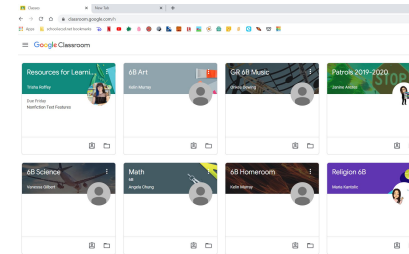

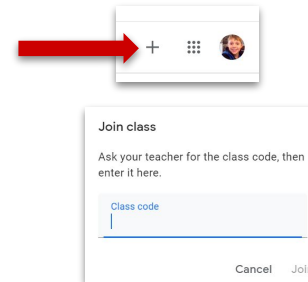
1 Click on ECSD Bookmarks bar and navigate to the Google Classroom.

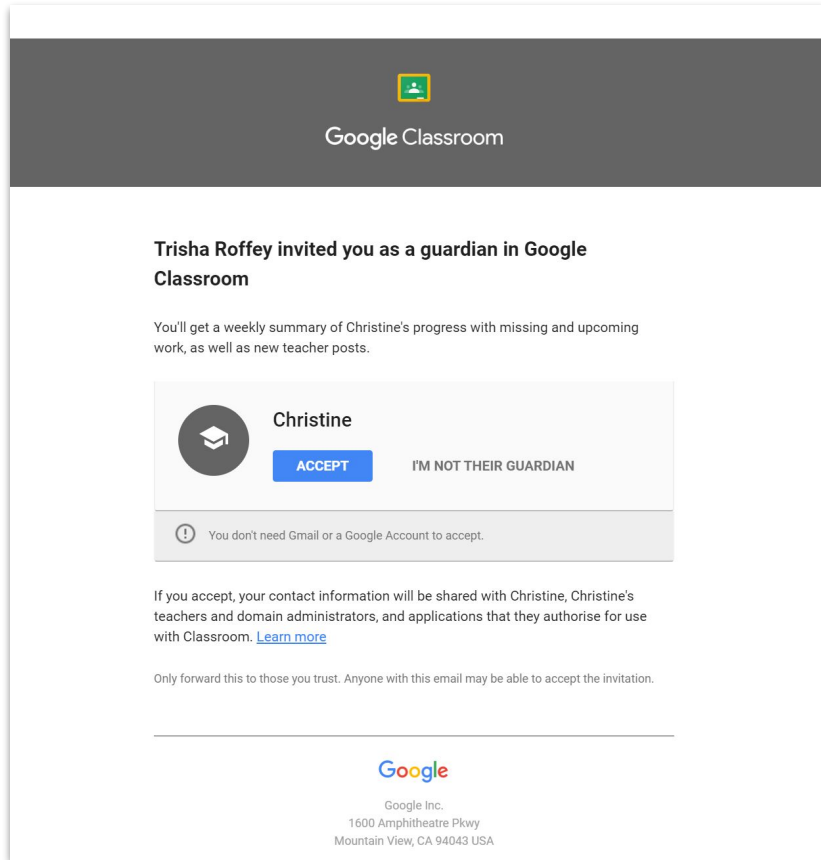
